Code of Conduct for Junior Members

All junior members of Read Cricket Club must:

- Play within the Spirit of Cricket as well as within the Laws.
- Abide by instructions given by the Team Manager/Coach.
- Respect opponents, officials, coaches and volunteers.
- Behave with self-discipline.
- At all times accept the Umpire's decision and never show dissent.
- Not use foul or abusive language on or off the field.
- Treat all players as you would like to be treated.
- Co-operate with Coaches, Team mates and Opponents – remember that without them there would be no game.
- Dress in an appropriate manner for training and matches (as agreed with coach)
- Never smoke on club premises or whilst representing the club.
- Never consume alcohol or drugs of any kind on club premises or whilst representing the club.

Code of Conduct for Parents/Guardians

Parents/Guardians must:

- Encourage your child to learn the rules and play within them.
- Discourage unfair play and arguing with officials.
- Help your child to recognise good performance, not just results.
- Set a good example by recognising fair play and applauding the good performances of all.
- Never punish or belittle a child for losing or making mistakes.
- Always accept the judgement of officials.
- Support your child's involvement and help them to enjoy the game.
